attach one recent passport sized photograph of yourself;
attach proof of your right to work if you are not an Australian citizen e.g. certificate of residence/visa;
attach 3 written references from current trainers or recognised industry participants testifying to your ability to educate racehorses and experience in strapping and caring for racehorses;
attach a permission to train, a written approval from the training facility you are proposing to train from where the applicant is not the owner;
attach photos of your stabling area, including flooring, feeding area, security, bedding, general stable area; attach a medical certificate if you intend to ride trackwork
It is a condition of any trainers' licence that trainers provide satisfactory evidence of appropriate Public Liability insurance arrangements.

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### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC) is collecting the information on this form to assess whether you are eligible for a licence. This is authorised by the *Racing Integrity Act 2016*. QRIC may give some or all of this information to the Queensland Police Service for the purpose of assessing your suitability to be a license holder.

### Once a completed written application is received and the application has passed the probity assessment:

- 1) Dependant or proven experience you may be required to demonstrate the practical skills required of a horse trainer.
- 2) Take a written test of horse knowledge, horse health, race day procedures and rules of racing.

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# **Licence Pre-requisites**

The Standard for licensing Scheme – Thoroughbreds indicates in Schedule 2 – Licence Categories the pre-requisite's to hold each type of trainer licence.

Pre-requisites for each licence type are:

Class A Trainer – An applicant for a Class A trainer Licence must:

- Train or race horses in the Metropolitan area:
- hold a General Trainer licence for five (5) years or more; and not be disqualified in the preceding ten (10) years.

**General Trainer** – An applicant for a General Trainer Licence must:

- have at least twelve (12) months experience, either full or part time, as a restricted trainer; and
- Sufficient starters to demonstrate competency.

In addition to the above requirements, the applicant may be required to provide evidence of extensive experience in related areas such as breeding, pre-training or similar occupation.

Restricted Trainer - An applicant for a Restricted trainer licence must;

- have formal experience in racing.
- Have a minimum of 6 months experience as a licensed stablehand is required; including strapping at the races on a variety of occasions and tracks. This requirement may be varied at the Commission's discretion where the applicant can demonstrate the appropriate level of skill. Actual evidence of skills and experience, by way of a log book signed by a trainer/steward/ assessor, may be requested by the Commission at any time

# **Statutory Declaration**

do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows:

- 1. I have read the Standards of the QRIC approved under the Racing Integrity Act 2016 (RIA), and published on the QRIC's website at www.qric.qld.gov.au, and I agree to be bound by these Standards.
- 2. I am aware and will abide by the RIA, Racing Act 2002 (RA) and the Rules of Racing and any lawful direction issued by a steward or authorised officer of the QRIC.
- 3. I am aware that I am required to continually update myself in relation to recent rule changes to the Rules of Racing that are published on the Racing Queensland website www.racingqueensland.com.au.
- 4. I understand that disciplinary action may be taken against me, including revocation of my licence, if I do not abide by the RIA, RA, Standards of the QRIC, the Rules of Racing or a lawful direction issued by a steward or authorised officer of the QRIC.
- **5**. I am not currently subject to any disciplinary action initiated by any other Control Body or Racing Jurisdiction. I will immediately inform the QRIC should any other Control Body initiate disciplinary action against me.
- 6. I consent to the QRIC disclosing my personal information to and obtaining information in relation to bets I place (in my own capacity or on behalf of any other person) from any entity operating:
  - Any totalisator operator in Australia or elsewhere;
  - b. Any bookmaker licensed to operate in Australia or elsewhere, including corporate bookmakers;
  - Any betting exchange (licensed or unlicensed) operating in Australia or elsewhere. c.
- 7. I understand that any entity that provides information to the QRIC in compliance with a request made by QRIC does so with my consent and is not breaching the *Information Privacy Act 2009* (Qld) or any other State or Commonwealth legislation concerning the protection of information concerning my personal affairs, in complying with the request by the QRIC.
- I am aware that the QRIC collates personal information relating to me as part of the process of retaining records of all 8. persons licensed by the QRIC. I consent to the QRIC disclosing and requesting personal information concerning my affairs as a licensee to/from:
  - a. Authorised employees and agents of the QRIC;
  - b. Other State and Commonwealth departments and agencies;
  - c. Racing Queensland or Principal Racing Authorities in other states and territories in Australia and elsewhere;
  - d. Your public liability insurer and any agent acting on behalf of your insurer;
  - e. An owner or licensee of a venue at which betting on a code of races is conducted;
  - f. WorkCover and providers of insurance in the racing industry
- 9. Lagree to advise the QRIC in writing if I do not consent to my name and contact details being published on the QRIC website.
- 10. I understand that the QRIC may investigate me for non-compliances under racing legislation. I acknowledge and agree that the QRIC may publish reports on its findings after any investigation on its website where the report, and a summary of it containing my name, will be available publicly. I consent to the disclosure of my personal information by the QRIC for this purpose and this consent continues after the expiry or termination of any licence held by me under racing legislation. I consent to my personal information being made available online and acknowledge that this means it may be accessed from outside Australia.

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- 11. I understand that the QRIC may grant me a licence on various conditions and that QRIC has the right to impose additional conditions on my licence, during any licensing period.
- 12. I have not been convicted or charged with a criminal offence anywhere in the 3 years prior that I have not already notified QRIC of.
- 13. I understand that, as a condition of the licence, I am required to notify the QRIC in detail within 14 days of being charged with an offence.
- 14. I understand that the QRIC may immediately suspend my licence if I fail to pay a debt owed to the Commission within 30 days or such other period of time as agreed between the Commission and the licence holder.
- 15. I understand that if I am placed on the Forfeit List by a control body that the treatment of Forfeits will apply including suspension/disqualification as per the Rules of Racing.
- 16. All information I have provided in this declaration is true and correct. I understand disciplinary action may be taken against me, including revocation of my licence, if I provide information to the QRIC that is incorrect in any particular.
- 17. I am aware and understand that it is an offence under section 214 of the RIA for me to knowingly make a false statement in an application for a licence. Subject to a maximum penalty of 200 penalty units or 2 years' imprisonment.
- 18. I have not taken part in any act of animal cruelty nor have instructed someone else (or given any express or implied approval to someone else) to take part in any act of animal cruelty.
- 19. To the best of my knowledge, no animal while under my care or ownership has been involved in any act of animal cruelty in relation to training in the past, including the practice known as live-baiting or blooding.

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Oaths Act 1867 (Qld).
